





#### **External Exam / Annual Exam**

- 80 marks in each main subject
- 50 marks in Skill subject \*\*
- Secure 33% of 80 marks & 50 marks

#### **Total Passing marks**

(26.4+6.6=33)

### Passing Criteria

- ❖80 marks written assessment in each subject will cover 100% syllabus of class IX only
- ❖If a student secure below 33% in any one of the three compulsory academic subjects (i.e. Science, Mathematics and Social Science) and passes in the Skill subject (offered as 6th optional subject), then it will be replaced by the Skill subject ie Information Technology.






### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

•If any changes are required to be made in Phone no., then kindly submit the application mentioning the new phone no. in the school office.


